

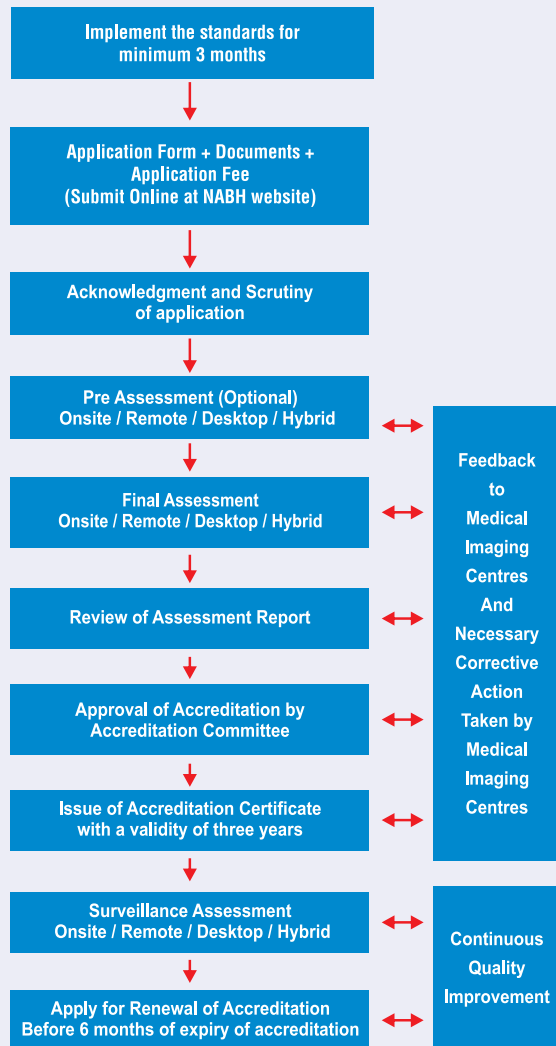

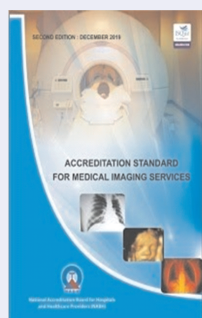

Introduction to NABH: National Accreditation Board for Hospitals and Health care Providers (NABH) is a constituent board of Quality Council of India (QCI) which is established with a vision to be the apex national healthcare accreditation and quality improvement body, functioning at par with global benchmarks. NABH as an organization is accredited by the International Society for Quality (ISQua) and is an institutional member of both ISQua and Asian Society for Quality (ASQua).

Medical Imaging Services Accreditation: The MIS accreditation was launched in the year 2010. The standards were developed with the main goal to improve the diagnostic accuracy and patient safety to cover the functions and systems of a whole diagnostic imaging and interventional radiology service & to address quality in service delivery and support quality improvement leading to best clinical outcomes.

These standards can be used by the MIS Centres to enter the realm of systematic quality management across a healthcare organization. The standards cover the vitals of quality and safety management and would facilitate in delivering high quality care.

The standards for NABH Accreditation for Medical Imaging Services provide general guidelines pertaining to all diagnostic and interventional imaging services.

Benefits of Accreditation:

- ❖ Patients are the biggest beneficiary as implementation of accreditation standards ensures Patient safety, commitment to quality care resulting in good clinical outcomes.
- ❖ Improves patient satisfaction and increases community confidence as services are provided by credentialed medical staff.

Who can apply?

Medical Imaging Services Centre that fulfills the following requirements:

- ❖ Currently in operation as Medical Imaging Services Centre
- ❖ Medical Imaging Services should have implemented NABH standards for a minimum of three months.
- ❖ The organization that commits to comply with relevant NABH standards, its policies and procedures and applicable legal/statutory/regulatory requirements.
- ❖ The organization who are either standalone/a part of an existing healthcare organization/chain of imaging centers.

How to apply for Accreditation?
