

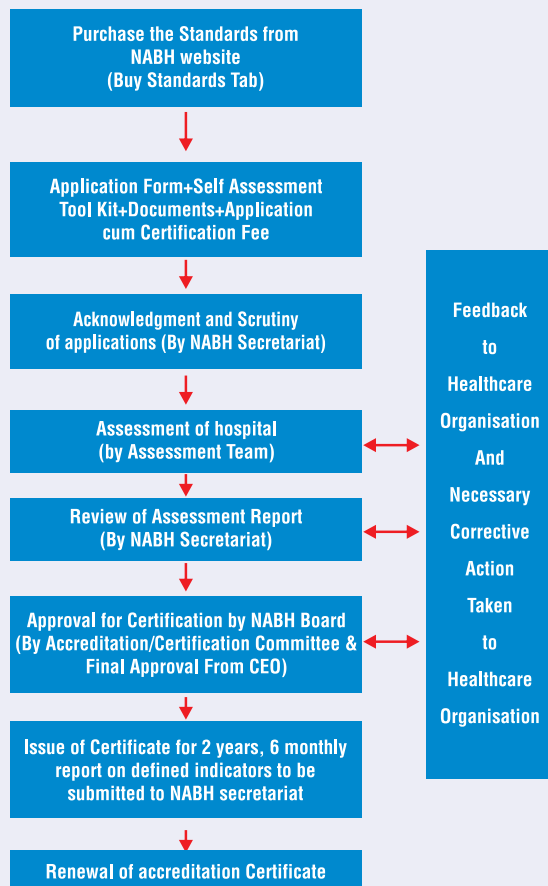

NABH as an organization is accredited by the International Society for Quality (ISQua) and is an institutional member of ISQua and ASQua.

Nursing Excellence Certification: The Nursing professionals are the cornerstone of any quality related programme in a health care organization. Keeping this in mind, Nursing excellence standards have been framed with a view to lay down the guidelines for evaluating the nursing services being provided by a Health Care Organization.

The 1st edition of the nursing excellence standards is divided into chapters, focusing on various professional, administrative and governance aspects of nursing.
